Another resident asked about having a better definition for "horseplay." The resident also asked about the "no events" sign at the pool and for more guidance on if residents want to get together.

The Board discussed and agreed to changing "horseplay" to "rough or rowdy play" and wanted a no smoking policy for the amenities. The Board also noted they should take out the section on the dog park and fix the error regarding guests.
